

Capability Statement

Helicopter Logistics is a Western Australian, specialist helicopter and fixed wing aircraft operator with extensive experience in remote area operations. The company was established in 2005 and is owned and managed by ex-Australian Defence Force members who are engaged in a variety of specialised aerial, ground, and maritime operations throughout Australia primarily for Federal and State Government agencies. In addition, the company provides a variety of bespoke charter, tourism, and aerial work services in specialised markets.

During the 15 years since the establishment of the company, Helicopter Logistics has achieved a 100% safety record. The company is enormously proud of this enviable achievement.

The company's head office is at Jandakot Airport, Western Australia. A southern base is located at Bunbury Airport and a northern base is located at Kununurra in the Kimberley region. Helicopter Logistics has an exclusive contract with Kimberley tour operator, Kingfisher Tours to support their tour operations during the tourist season commencing April 1 to September 30 each year.

Helicopter Logistics has its own aviation maintenance support business, Helicopter Logistics Engineering, whereby the company's rotary and fixed wing fleet is maintained in-house by company personnel under a CAR 30 Certificate of Approval covering airframe and engine maintenance plus component overhaul.

Helicopter Logistics has an excellent relationship with the Australian aviation safety regulator, CASA, and is well known for providing a highly regarded, extremely safe and professional service. Rigorous annual audits for mining related work are conducted by the Flight Safety Foundation which enables Helicopter Logistics to provide specialised services to the Foundation's Members, including BHP and Rio Tinto. The company has developed a comprehensive Safety Management System that is the framework for an extensive number of safety systems that collectively deliver processes and procedures for the daily operation of the business. In addition, the company is currently transitioning through accreditation for:

1. ISO 9001 Quality Management System
2. ISO 4801 OHS Management System
3. ISO 14001 Environment Management System

Since 2013 the company has held several rotary and fixed wing contracts with the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions (DBCA) and the Department of Fire and Emergency Services. These contracts are for land management and bushfire support operations with a large focus on surveillance and intelligence gathering. The company is also approved to provide aviation services for the Western Australian Department of Premier and Cabinet.

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
